E-East Side: Betsy Ross Crossing (BRC), Betsy Ross House (BRH), 235 Broadway, 425 Broadway & Mill Cove.

W-West Side: Ridgeland Est. & Gardens, Landry Vill & Adam Ct., Thorn. Heights Community, 1700/St. Cyr & Jocelyn Place. If the SPHA bus is full, please feel free to take your own car, however, just let Janet know ahead of time.
